


How many cells are in your body?

House of peas!


First, think about the size of your house.

PEAS!










Either colour in the pictures OR DRAW ALL THE PEAS!

and all the cupboards and boxes... every room is filled with peas!



Draw your house filled with peas.




*this is how you write
