SCIENCE SCAVENGER HUNT

We would like you to join us on a **SCIENCE SCAVENGER HUNT!**



Scientists use lots of high-tech equipment in the lab to do their research. However, some of the things scientists use are similar to every-day items we might find in our house. This scavenger hunt is just for fun, and the items you find cannot be used for protective equipment.

Can you find all of the below items in your house?

If there's anything on the list you can't find, we've come up with some alternatives you could find, or you could try making or drawing it instead.

You may want to ask someone in your house to help you with this activity!

- Safety equipment: Scientists need to wear all their safety equipment in the lab, such as a lab coat, gloves and safety goggles. Can you find a coat, a pair of gloves and a pair of goggles? If you can't find goggles, try finding sunglasses instead! Ask a parent or guardian to take a photo of you in your 'safety equipment' and share it with us on social media.
- Measuring beaker: Scientists need to measure chemicals
 carefully. Can you find something to measure liquids with, such as
 a measuring jug? Try measuring 500ml of water using the
 measuring jug.
- **Stopwatch:** Scientists sometimes have to time their experiments carefully using a stopwatch. Can you find something to time 'experiments' with, such as a watch or clock? Try timing yourself doing 30 seconds of star jumps.
